The Hilton Tulum Riviera Maya is the subject of our destination spotlight in this issue — it will give you an idea of how Hilton is raising the bar on its all-inclusive properties.

If you're hoping hotel rates might be coming down, this report tells us that's not likely for 2023 or 24 or? In a February 9 earnings call, Hilton chief Christopher Nassetta made it clear that guest-room prices for all customer segments will remain stubbornly high for the foreseeable future. And for planners looking at budgets (and who amongst us doesn't have to look at budgets?) the increasing service fees on F&B are also a concern. Top rates that used to be 22% have now soared to 28% and increasingly fees are being added to AV and room rental. You can read some thoughts and tips here.

And by coincidence, according to the new Northstar/Cvent Meetings Industry <u>PULSE Survey</u>, half of meeting and event planners are experiencing increased demand for properties that can deliver all elements of their events, including guest rooms, meeting space, F&B, A/V, and entertainment,. In a difficult <u>negotiating environment</u>, organizers appreciate one point of contact for easier budgeting, booking, billing and more, while participants appreciate an easier agenda and the freedom to choose how they spend their leisure time.

Incentive travel is booming, apparently! By all indicators, incentive travel is not just back on track; it's well on the way to reaching prepandemic levels. Three times as many planners were actively booking new programs in Q4 2022, compared with Q4 2021, according to the latest Northstar/Cvent Incentive PULSE Survey.

If I only knew more...

Active participation in sustainability efforts is a choice that cane seem overwhelming, and as with any choice, you need access to information to make an informed decision. The right decision. A decision that fits the personality and goals of your company.

There is a bright spot on the hotel side! Donating food is now easier thanks to the Food Donation Improvement Act, signed into Federal law in January 2023. It expands the protections of the 1996 <u>Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Food Donation Act</u> and gives greater liability protections for event organizers who donate surplus food and grocery products. More details here.

If you organize international programs, be aware that <u>passport</u> <u>renewal</u> is currently taking up to eleven weeks, with delays likely to increase. In January, the State Department tweeted it was "experiencing record passport demand for this time of year, often receiving more than 500,000 new passport applications each week. Just a reminder, most countries ask for a minimum of six months validity beyond the date of travel from the US, although there are agreements in place with some countries to waive this requirement.

In the airline world, Delta has worked hard since the pandemic to improve efficiency and upgrade processes for its Delta Edge Meetings program. Additionally, it's been developing an enhanced meetings platform, and customer are eligible for incentives for meetings with 50 or more attendees traveling on Delta or codeshare flights. Espresso martinis and dessert cart are also currently headlining Delta's food & beverage refresh, so if you have the chance to experience that, let us know. Definitely sounds delicious! There is some potential good news about the fees we all encounter while traveling. U.S. presidents don't usually wade into the minutiae of airline seat selection, yet that's exactly what President Joe Biden did during his State of the Union Address earlier this year, spending nearly two minutes of the speech decrying "junk fees" such as those airlines can charge families who want to sit together when flying. Airlines and hotels have started to provide greater transparency about add-ons and fees, and government action on 'junk fee' legislation could take that further and simplify travel pricing. More on this from our friends at Northstar.
